- Sterile stretch gauze bandage (3" x 48")
- Dermicil hypoallergenic cloth tape (1' x 300")
- Kaopectate tablets (maximum strength)
- Custom splints
- Ziplock bags
- Hemostats
- Paperwork with dog's health records
- Muzzle
